

## **New regulations for waste disposal as from 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019**

The Municipality of Stavanger has introduced new regulations related to household waste.

For St. Olav this means that plastic items now shall be disposed of together with ordinary household waste and dumped in the garbage chute.

Glass and bottles shall be disposed of at the environmental station at the road crossing St. Svithunsgate and Møllegata by the Extra shop.

It is important to pack the plastic well, together with other household waste, to provide enough weight to ensure that it falls to the bottom of the shaft.

**Note! Do not throw empty plastic bags into the garbage chute as these will be sucked upwards and may block the ventilator on top of the shaft.**

**Blockage of the ventilator may cause unpleasant smell.**

### **Advice from the janitors:**

#### **Waste disposal /garbage chute**

- Put the household waste (and plastic) in a bag and close it tightly before putting it into the garbage chute. Other waste or items may jam the chute.
- Open bags and paper waste will be sucked upwards and may block the ventilator on top of the shaft. Blockage of the ventilator may cause unpleasant smell in the corridors.
- Pizza boxes shall be put in the green paper waste containers in U3 (garage), not into the chute.
- All paper waste shall be put in the green paper waste containers in U3.
- Carton boxes must be folded and placed next to the green paper waste containers, not into the containers.
- Bottles, glass and metal items / cans must be deposited at the environmental station at the end of the pedestrian street next to St. Olavsgt. 13.
- Unwanted advertisements from the post box shall be put in the green paper waste containers in U3.
- Christmas trees are deposited next to the environmental station at the end of the pedestrian street next to St. Olavsgt. 13. These will be collected 15-20 days after Christmas.

Note!! The garage space is only allowed for car parking. Storage of other items (except storage of tyres) are forbidden by the Fire Brigade due to fire hazard.
